

Women’s imprisonment factsheet: Nottinghamshire

- 194 immediate prison sentences were given to women in Nottinghamshire in 2024, an increase from 150 in 2023 and a 32% increase since 2014. 67% were for less than six months.¹
- 58% of the prison sentences were for theft offences.
- The use of community sentences for women in Nottinghamshire has decreased by 27% since 2014.
- The use of cautions has decreased by 66% since 2014.²







Women’s imprisonment – the national picture

There are more than twice as many women in prison in England and Wales today as there were in 1993.

- The women’s prison population on Monday 29 September 2025 was 3,504.³
- Women were sent to prison on 6,190 occasions in 2024 – either on remand or to serve a sentence.⁴
- 75% of immediate prison sentences given to women in 2024 were for less than 12 months.⁵
- In 2024 there were 2,920 recalls of women to custody. Women serving sentences of less than 12 months accounted for almost two-thirds (63%) of all recalls.⁶
